Position Overview

The **URBAN YOUTH CORPS PARTICIPANT** will perform routine duties necessary for the orderly operation of the parks and recreational facility.

Work may be performed in various areas within the Leisure Services Department which may include work with ball fields, parks, cemeteries or other outdoor/indoor areas.

The City of Gulfport Leisure Services Department is seeking five (5) parks and recreation workers for the ***2013 Urban Youth Corps Program***.

The ***Urban Youth Corps Program*** is offered through a partnership between the Mississippi Department of Transportation and the City of Gulfport to provide participants with on-the-job training, work experience and basic life skills.

- **Requirements:** Applicants must be ages 16 to 25 years, and full-time high school or college students. No previous experience is required.
- **Duties:** Work will involve City of Gulfport parks and recreation maintenance such as landscaping flower beds, weeding, watering plants, and related duties in the City of Gulfport parks and recreation division.
- **Wages:** The program will last for up to 10 weeks, beginning in June and ending in early August. This is a temporary part-time position paying \$9.25 per hour for approximately 32 hours per week.

You may submit an application to the City of Gulfport Human Resources Department in person, by mail, e-mail, or fax. Applications submitted by e-mail or fax must be followed by an original application within **3 days** of submission or the copy will be rendered null and void.
