Position Overview

The Signs & Markings Tech Level I performs routine unskilled manual laboring tasks and limited semi-skilled tasks in the carrying out of a variety of maintenance, construction and service activities. Assignments include the use of standard hand tools and power operated devices, the operation of trucks and other automotive equipment incident to regular duties. Work usually is performed under direct supervision.

Essential Job Functions

Essential duties and functions, pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act, May include the following. Other related duties may be assigned.

- Measure and mark off streets, stalls and lanes for street painting; layout and apply thermo plastic
- Paint curbs, crosswalks, and do street lettering
- Operate the striping machine; operate paint controls when assigned
- Select and mark proper locations for signs and posts
- Fabricate City street signs; use and operate airless spray equipment, striping machine, and hot plastic equipment

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Must possess required knowledge, skills, abilities and experience and be able to explain and demonstrate, with or without reasonable accommodations, that the essential functions of the job can be performed.

- Ability to read, write and/or follow oral instructions.
- Ability to learn the use of hand and power tools incidental to assigned tasks.

Education and Experience

High School graduate or equivalent. Some experience in the area of work assigned sufficient to perform assigned tasks.

Required Licenses or Certificates

Must possess valid driver's license.

Physical Demands and Working Conditions

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Physical requirements include occasional lifting/carrying of 50+ pounds; visual acuity, speech and hearing; hand and eye coordination and manual dexterity necessary to operate a computer keyboard and basic office equipment. Subject to sitting, standing, reaching, walking, twisting and kneeling to perform the essential functions. Working conditions are both indoors and outdoors.
