

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PLUMBING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gulfport, Mississippi, has the authority to establish a fee schedule for the issuance of plumbing permits; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: In the Code of Ordinance, the current Section 3-83 is hereby deleted and the following Section 3-83 is hereby adopted.

The installation, enlargement, alteration, repair, removal, conversion or replacement any plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by the adopted plumbing code, by a licensed plumbing contractor shall first make application to the code official and obtain the required permit before the work is started in accordance with the schedule listed below.

Plumbing Permit Fee Schedule

Permit fees shall include a base permit fee for issuing each permit plus a fee for each fixture listed below.
