Least Terns and Black Skimmers are nesting on Mississippi coastal beaches! **Volunteers are needed on weekends May-July 2015 to educate beach-goers and help protect beach nesting birds. We need folks to work as Colony monitors,**

Sentinels, and Outreach Educators.

Our beach nesting birds face many threats during this critical nesting time. The influx of visitors and beachgoers recreating on beaches during weekends and busy holidays make it even tougher for these birds while raising their young on local beaches.

There are beach-nesting bird sites along the Mississippi Gulf Coast in Pass Christian, Long Beach, Gulfport, and Biloxi. Volunteers are asked to commit 2 or 4 hours per shift on weekends during these hours: (8am-6pm). No experience is necessary! Training will be provided. Space is limited. (Unable to attend? Training will be provided on site.)
