



The Gulfport Police Department is offering four, one week youth fishing camps for 2017. The camps are for kids ages 9 – 13. Participants are instructed on the fundamentals of fishing or given new pointers to those already familiar with the sport. MS Department of Marine Resources will also instruct campers on Boating Safety and Laws. The campers will also learn about the fishing culture on the Mississippi Gulf Coast. Each participant is provided with fishing tackle and rod. At the successful completion of the camp each participant will be given their equipment so they can continue to enjoy the sport. Snacks and water will be provided also. There is no fee for this camp.
