Chief Alan Weatherford today announced that:

On April 02, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 16 year old black female Shonda L. Martin, 16 year old black female Laroya Magee, and 18 year old black male Kendrick Chapman all of Gulfport and charged them all with one count of burglary of a residence and one count of armed robbery.

The arrest stems from a complaint of a home invasion style robbery in the 3100 block of 8th Avenue. The victim stated that two females and two males forced their way into his apartment armed with weapons and took miscellaneous items. The victim recognized one of the females as an acquaintance. Through the course of the investigation Martin, Magee, Chapman and 20 year old black male Colton Walker of Gulfport were indentified.

Martin, Magee and Chapman were incarcerated at the Harrison County Adult Detention Center. Martin and Magee's bond was set at \$200,000.00 and Chapman's bond was set at \$50,000.00 all set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux.

Walker is still at large.
