UPDATE

On April 02, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 16 year old black female Shonda L. Martin, 16 year old black female Laroya Magee, and 18 year old black male Kendrick Chapman all of Gulfport and charged all with one count of burglary of a residence and one count of armed robbery.

On April 3, 2010, 16 year old Kendall Chapman of Gulfport was arrested and was also charged with burglary of a residence and armed robbery.

On April 8, 2010, 20 year old Colton Walker of Gulfport was arrested and charged with burglary of a residence and armed robbery.

These arrests stem from a complaint of a home invasion style robbery in the 3100 block of 8th Avenue. The victim stated the suspects forced their way into his apartment armed with weapons and took miscellaneous items. The victim recognized one of the females as an acquaintance. Through the course of the investigation Martin, Magee, Kendrick Chapman, Kendall Chapman and Walker were identified as suspects.

All were incarcerated in the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility. Kendall Chapman's bond was set at \$50,000.00 and Walker's bond was set at \$150,000.00, by Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux.
