On April 7, 2010, officers from the Gulfport Police Department arrested 20 year old Nathan Dean Bryant Jr. and 22 year old Erin Lynn Millis, both of Gulfport, and charged them with burglary of a business. Millis was also served with an outstanding warrant for burglary.

On April 7, 2010, at approximately 11:22 p.m. officers from the Gulfport Police Department responded to "Cindy's Sno Ball Stand" located at 96 Courthouse Road for a possible burglary in progress. Upon arrival officers found Bryant inside the business and Millis outside the business with stolen property. Both were subsequently arrested on scene and it was found that Millis had an outstanding warrant for burglary with the Gulfport Police Department.

Millis was also taken into custody for the December 19, 2009, burglary of Alice's Café located at 2918 7th Avenue, where evidence was found that placed her at the scene during the burglary.

Upon advising Justice Court Judge Louise Ladner of the underlying facts and circumstances she placed bond at \$50,000.00. Millis also has also had her bond revoked on the outstanding warrant for burglary. Upon booking and processing both were transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility.
