On April 18, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 20 year old white male Jeffery Allen Newbury of Gulfport and charged him with 10 counts of vehicle burglary and one count of attempted vehicle burglary.

On April 19, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 19 year old black male Sean Anthony Coleman of Gulfport and charged him with one count of vehicle burglary.

The arrest stems from a rash of vehicle burglaries which occurred in the Orange Grove area over the weekend. In total 18 vehicle burglaries were reported during this time period.

In an unrelated call in Harrison County Newbury was arrested on unrelated charges. A subsequent investigation tied Newbury to 11 of the burglaries and Coleman one and numerous of the items were recovered. More charges and arrests are expected as the investigation continues.

Newbury and Coleman were incarcerated at the Harrison County Adult Detention Center. Newbury's bond was set at \$55,000.00 per Harrison County Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux. Coleman's bond was set at \$25,000.00 by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Diane Ladner.
