On August 27, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 20 year old Anthony Madale Moody, of Gulfport, and charged him with possession of stolen property. On August 31, 2010, 48 year old Larry Bell, of Gulfport, was arrested and charged with motor vehicle theft.

On August 08, 2010, at approximately 10:16 a.m. officers from the Gulfport Police Department responded to Allen Toyota, located at 624 East Pass Road, for a report of motor vehicle theft. After arriving on scene, it was learned that a thin black male, approximately 6' tall, had taken a truck from the parking lot. The stolen truck was later recovered after a concerned citizen reported suspicious activity. During the course of the investigation Moody and Bell were developed as suspects.

On August 27, 2010, Moody and Bell were taken into custody without incident at the Gulfport Police Department. Bell and Moody were then transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of a \$20,000.00, bond set by Justice Court Judge Melvin Ray.

On August 31, 2010, after further investigation, Bell was charged with motor vehicle theft and remained in the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility with a \$20,000.00 bond.
