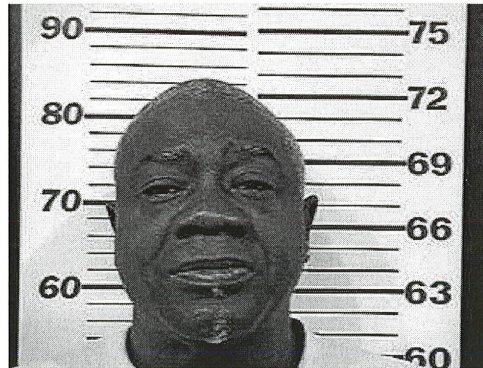

On January 29, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 53 year old black male Michael Morgan of Gulfport and charged him with one count of residential burglary.

The arrest stems from a complaint from a witness who heard some one breaking into a residence in the 3600 block of 16th Street. The witness contacted the police who responded and placed Morgan into custody.

Morgan was incarcerated at the Harrison County Adult Detention Center in lieu of a \$50,000.00 set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Melvin Ray.

Chief Alan Weatherford states, "Without the vigilance of this concerned citizen, this arrest would not have been possible." Weatherford also urges the communities to get involved, and when they see or hear something suspicious, they should contact the Gulfport Police Department.
