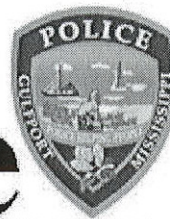

Chief Alan Weatherford today announced that:

On January 05, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 45 year old Randy D. Boyd of Gulfport, and charged him with two (02) counts of felony driving under the influence.

On October 21, 2009 Boyd was stopped in the 10500 block of Three Rivers Road and charged with a misdemeanor driving under the influence.

On November 1, 2009, Boyd was stopped once again by officers in the area of Courthouse Road and Pass Road and charged with misdemeanor driving under the influence.

It was then found on November 19, 2009, that Boyd had two previous convictions in the last five (05) years for driving under the influence. Upon presenting the under lying facts and circumstances to Justice Court Judge Louise Ladner she issued a warrant for his arrest on two (02) counts of felony driving under the influence.

On January 5, 2010, Boyd turned himself in on the outstanding warrant at the Gulfport Police Department. Upon completion of booking and processing Boyd was transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of a \$50,000.00 bond.
