On June 01, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 17 year old black male Corey Donald Johnson of Gulfport and charged him with one count of robbery.

The arrest stems from a complaint filed on May 31, 2010, where Johnson and two other black male circled a juvenile in the area of South Carolina Avenue and Madison Street, demanding the juvenile's shoes. The juvenile became scared and gave them his shoes. Then one of the black males snatched the juvenile's cell phone from his hands and fled the area. An arrest warrant was obtained for Johnson. The other two subjects were not identified.

On June 01, 2010, Johnson was arrested at his residence without incident and incarcerated at the Harrison County Adult Detention Center in lieu of a \$50,000.00 bond set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Gene Dedeaux. Johnson was also off-bonded. Johnson was out on bond for an armed robbery in 2009.
