On March 29, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 47 year old white male Joseph Hanzalik of Gulfport and charged him with two count of burglary of a shed and one count of possession of stolen property. The Gulfport Police Department also arrested 33 year old white male Todd Lampkin of Gulfport and charged him with one count of burglary of a shed and one count of possession of stolen property.

The arrests stem from a complaint initiated on January 29, 2010, where the victim reported that his storage shed, located in the 9100 block of Lorraine Road had been broken into too. The victim discovered that some paint ball equipment and several thousand rounds of ammunition were stolen. The Gulfport Police Department received information that Hanzalik was pawning some of the stolen items in Alabama.

On March 27, 2010, the same victim reported that someone attempted to break into his storage shed again.

On March 29, a victim of a grand larceny from Biloxi contacted the Gulfport Police and advised he located his stolen trailer in the rear of a residence in the 2200 block of Gulf Avenue.

On March 29, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department executed a search warrant in the 2200 block of Gulf Avenue and located the trailer along with other items stolen from the storage shed on January 29, 2010. Both Hanzalik and Lampkin were taken into custody.

Hanzalik and Lampkin were incarcerated at the Harrison County Adult Detention Center. Hanzalik's bond was set at \$300,000.00 (\$100,000.00 per count) and Lampkin's bond was set at \$100,000.00 (\$50,000.00 per count). All bonds were set by Harrison County Justice Court Judge Diane Ladner.
