On May 12, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department arrested 27 year old Nathan Simmons and charged him with grand larceny.

On April 25, 2010, the Gulfport Police Department responded to the 1000 block of 45th Avenue for a report of grand larceny. Upon arrival it was learned that Simmons had stayed at the residence and while he was there stole the homeowners jewelry and pawned it at area pawn shops.

Upon review of the underlying facts and circumstances with Justice Court Judge Melvin Ray he issued a warrant for Simmons' arrest.

On the night of May 12, 2010, Simmons was located in the area of Highway 49 and Dedeaux Road and was taken into custody without incident. Upon the completion of booking and processing, Simmons was transported to the Harrison County Adult Detention Facility in lieu of bond. Simmons was also wanted for violation of his release with the Mississippi Department of Corrections.
