Project Scope:

The existing bridge was rated at below 50% and it was determined by Gulfport, Biloxi, and Harrison County that the bridge should be replaced. Harrison County became the lead agency as Mississippi State Aid Road Construction funds were eligible to be used to pay for a portion of the replacement costs. All State Aid Road Construction funds are administered through Harrison County. Harrison County agreed to apply through State Aid and hire the Engineer to design the new bridge. Once the bridge was fully designed by the consulting firm of A. Garner Russell & Associates, the estimated total cost of the bridge is \$9.0 Million due to the length of span (3060 L.F.) across the Biloxi River Floodway. State Aid has guaranteed \$3.0 Million. In 2012, the three local agencies requested and were approved additional funding in the amount of \$4.1 Million from Gulf Regional Planning Commission. Therefore, the remaining amount is divided between Gulfport, Biloxi, and Harrison County.
