



**NOTICE OF WATER AND SEWER TRANSPORT RATE INCREASE
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2019**

The water and sewer transport rates for the City of Gulfport will increase as of October 1, 2019, in accordance with [City Ordinance 2834](#). The Garbage collection rate will increase as of October 1, 2019, in accordance with [City Ordinance 2920](#). The water and sewer transport rate increase, which was approved by the City Council in October, 2015 will fund various capital projects, as well as water and sewer infrastructure repairs and updates. The Garbage collection rate increase, which was approved by the City Council in September, 2017 will fund ongoing collection and disposal of garbage, trash and refuse in the City of Gulfport.

The average person will use 2,000 gallons of water per month which is also the minimum amount that you will be billed. The average *minimum* bill for one person will be \$39.90
